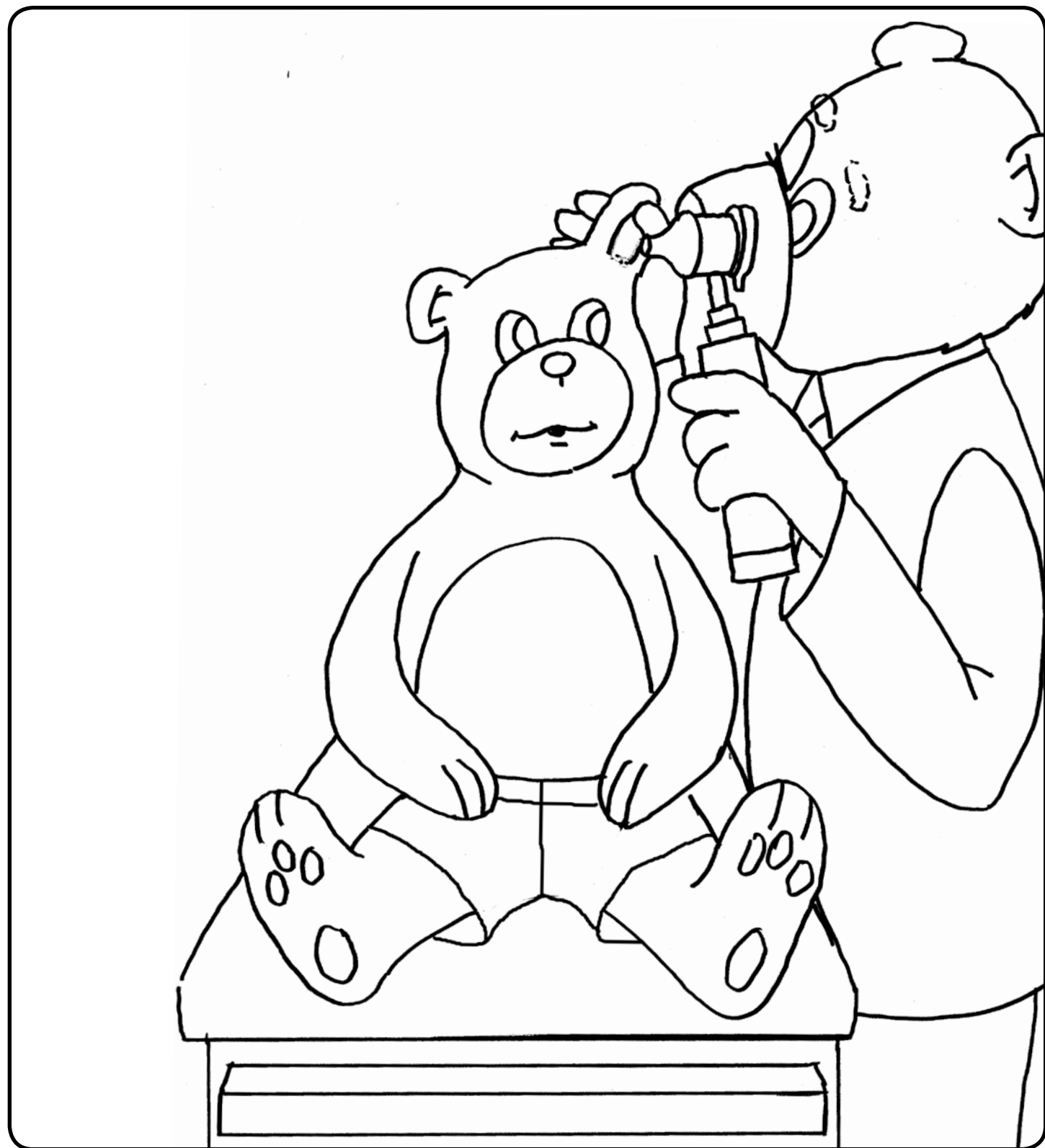
How big am I?



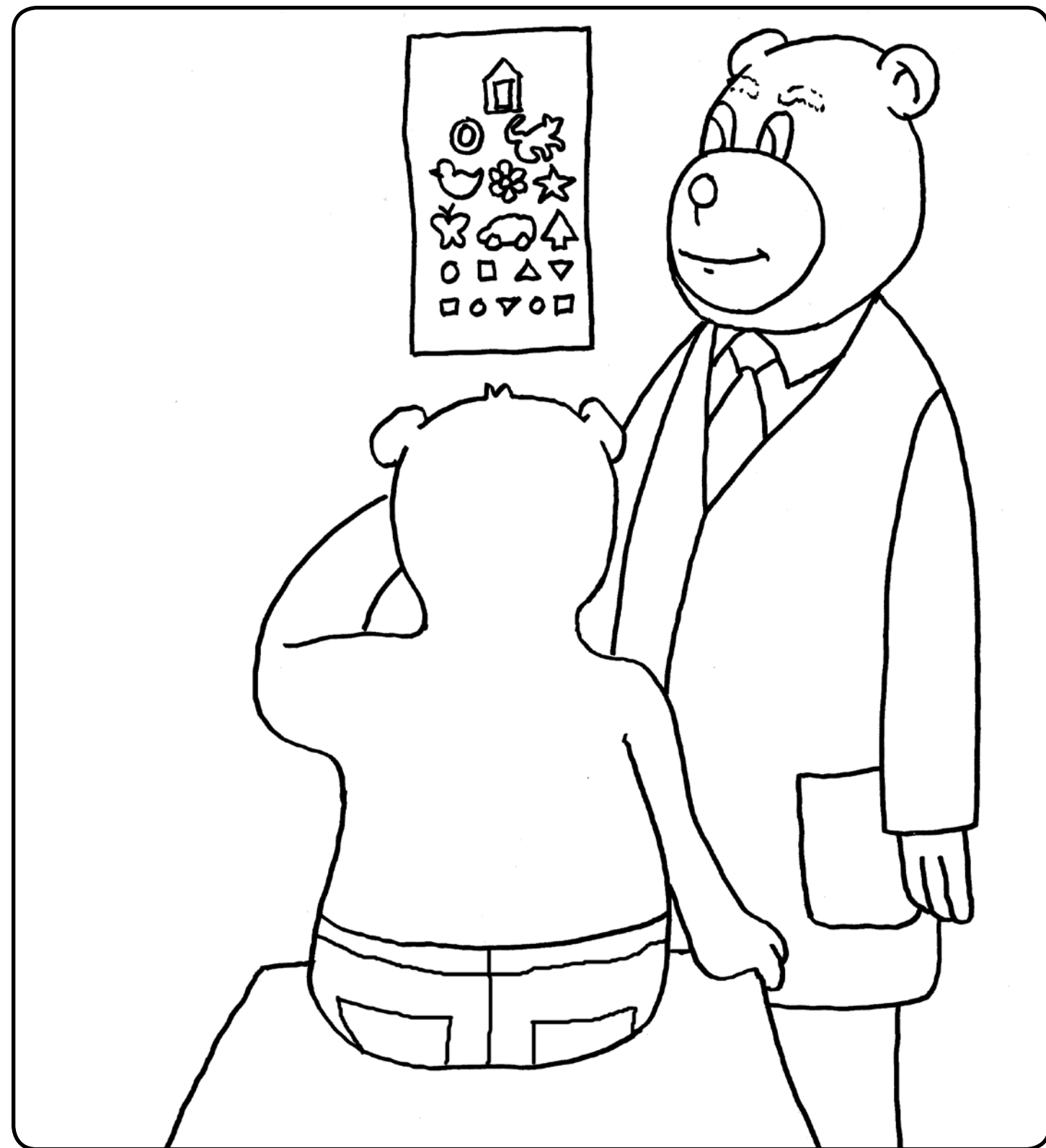
Open wide! My throat looks pink inside.
